We met in November for our annual Pizza Party and it was another success. Good friends, good pizza and good desserts make up a good evening at the airport. Photos follow.

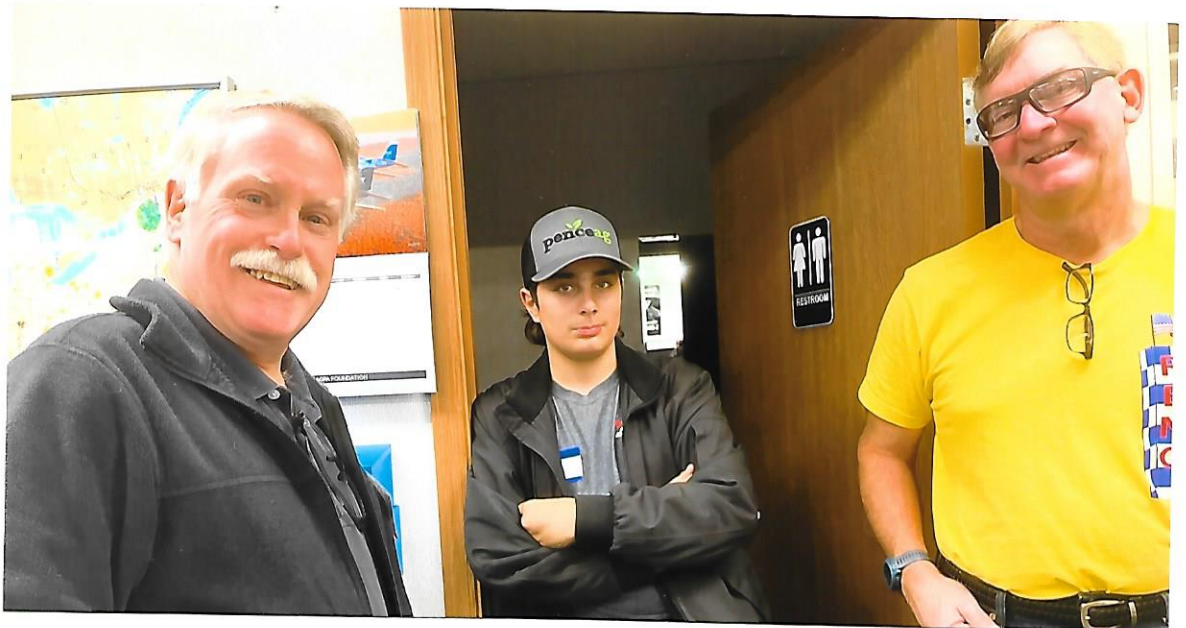

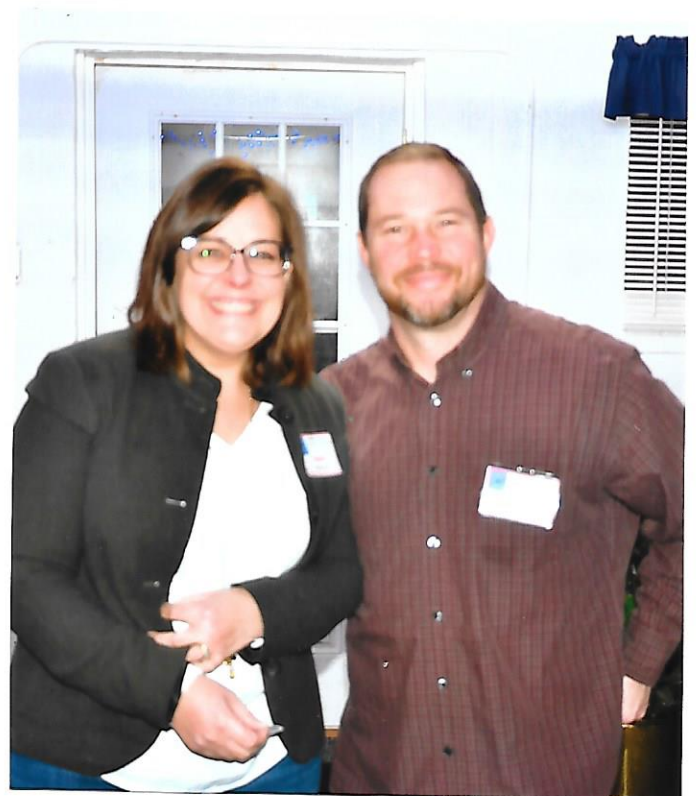

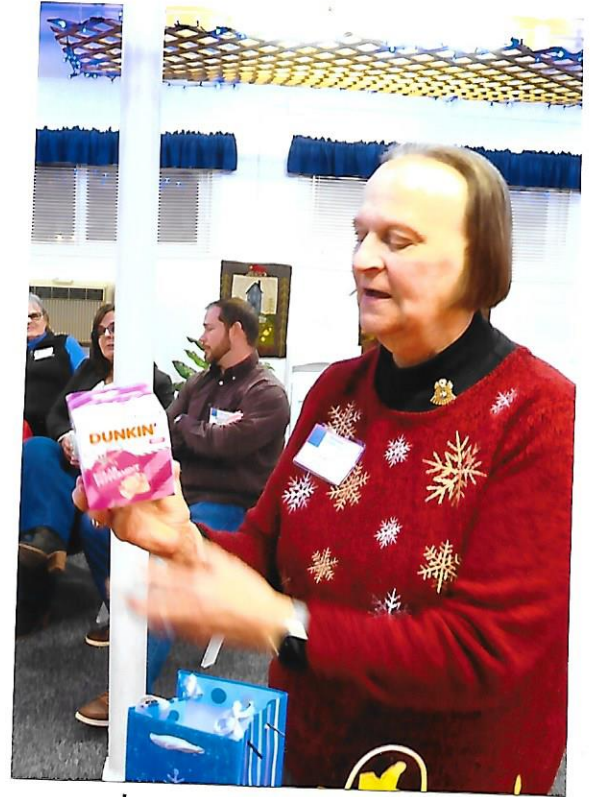
