Vern led in prayer which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Vern reported that Lou is recovering from a stroke and could not attend.

Then Vern presented the financial report. We have a balance in the bank of \$5,641.70 and \$20 yet to be deposited. Insurance was paid in the amount of \$541.

Jim reported Dallas and Phyllis Harding were back in Indiana for a few days and he enjoyed lunch with Dallas. Their new home construction in Vermont is proceeding nicely.
