The April cookout was then discussed and arrangements firmed up with Jim in charge of the barbecue and others volunteering for additional items.

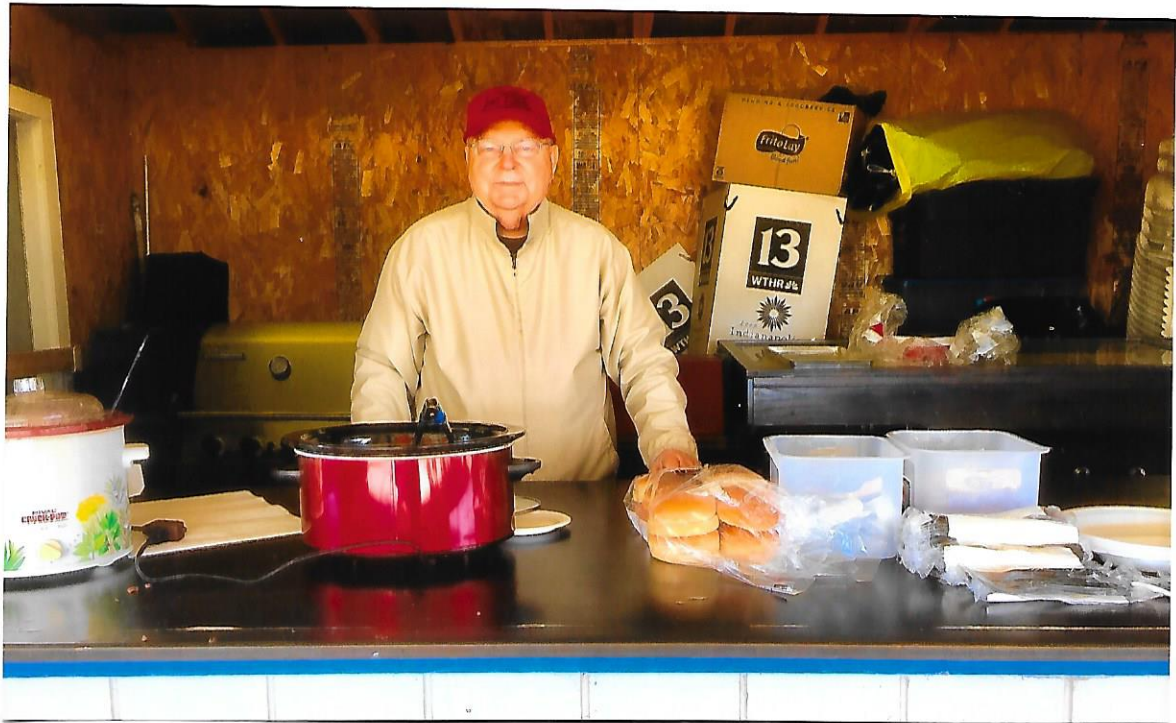

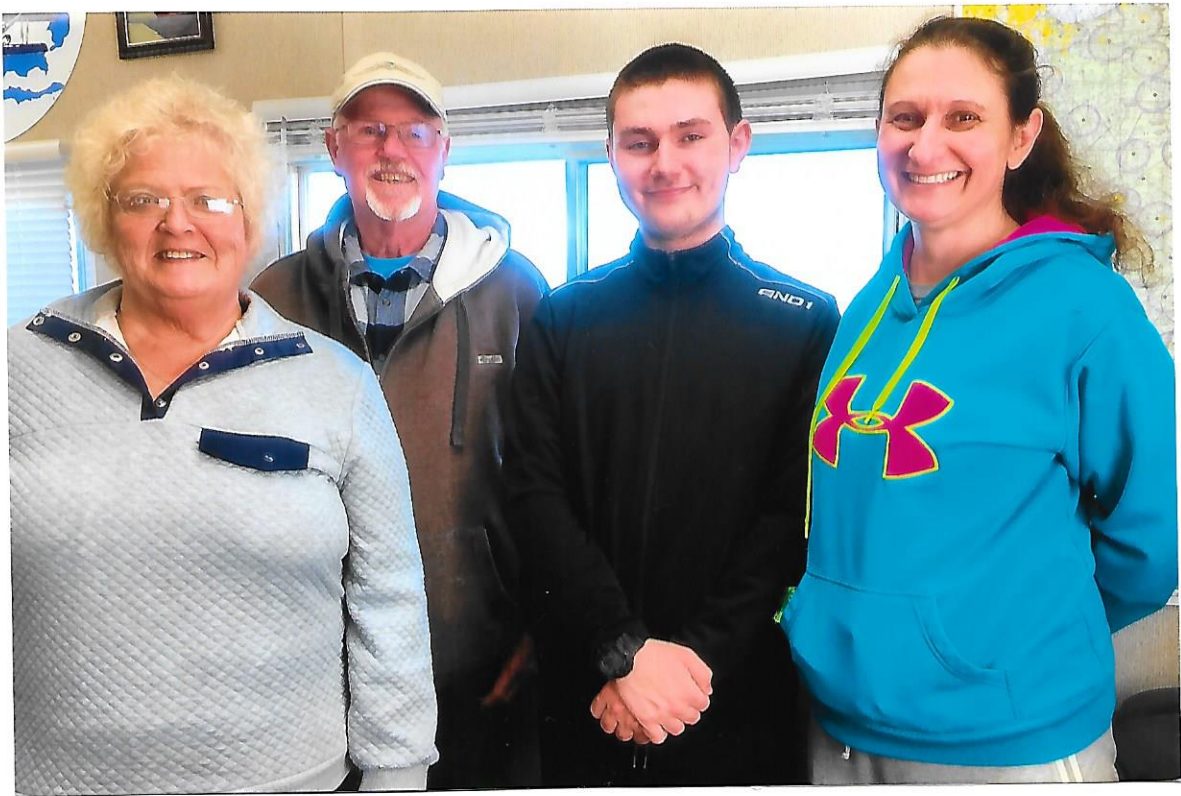

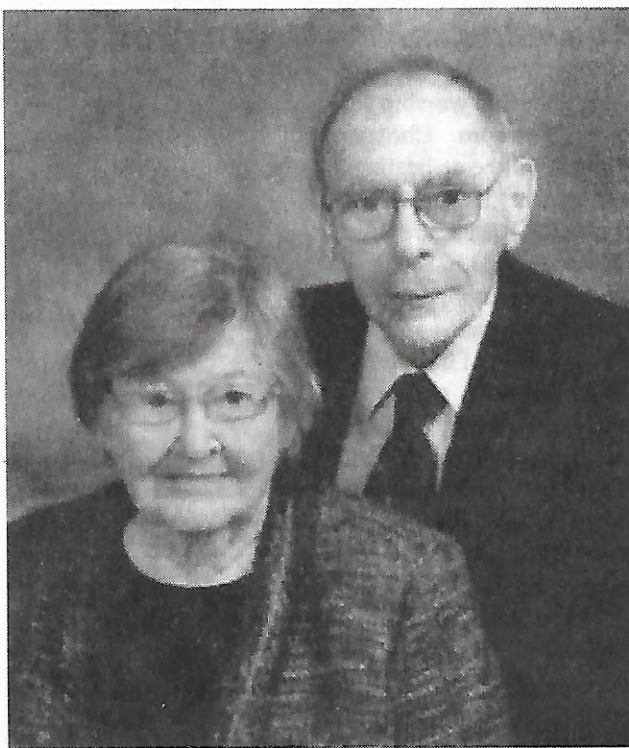
