BOARD MEETING NEWS

Your HCAA board held the March/April meeting on March 28. In attendance were Jim Snyder, Jim Graham, Don Hughes, John Rothrock, Ted Bock, Vern Sullenger, Tammy Halbrook and Wilma Winings.

A schedule of events for the year was set up and is found elsewhere in this newsletter. A date and place for our December Christmas event has not been finalized as yet. Several locations were discussed and Tammy is checking on a few more and will present that information to the board.

Jim Graham reported that the runway will be resurfaced as soon as a provider is selected. He also mentioned that the operations building (office) is expected to be replaced with a permanent building in about a year. There are no plans for an extension of the runway at this time.

John Rothrock mentioned that an air compressor is needed for airing up tires for transients as well as airport tenants. It will probably require a designated electrical outlet for this, separately from the gas pumps. He is going to follow up with the IAA to see what can be done. HCAA would finance this convenience unless IAA wishes to do so.
